APPEALS FOR HELP

Appeal from Federation of Zoroastrian Associations of North America (FEZANA):

During the year FEZANA Welfare Committee gets a number of requests, and after due diligence does it's best with the limited resources available. When you donate for a cause and the requirements are fulfilled, the money remains in the fund and is disbursed to the next applicant. We have helped community members here in North America and throughout the world.

At present we have been asked to assist a 35 year old single parent who has a 7 year old daughter. The mother has been treated for Encephalitis for the past four and a half months in Mumbai, India. She is partially paralyzed and is getting treatment through medication and physiotherapy. Her and her retired parents savings have been depleted to meet medical expenses.

We pray Ahura Mazda grants her strength to regain her health so that she can be there to guide her daughter to a good Zarathushti life and take care of her parents in their retired life.

APPEALS FOR HELP (continued)

Appeal from The Zoroastrian Association of California (ZAC):

ZAC has received the following appeal from Ahmedabad, India. Delnaz Rayomand Kerawala born on 5th Feb, 1993 - 18 years old, was detected in May 2010 with stage II bone cancer which in medical terms is known as "E wing's Sarcoma / PNET, left retroperitoneal mass".

Delnaz is under treatment of Dr. Mandeep Shah who is an Orthopedic Oncologist. In her case, due to the very big tumor, she has already undergone 5 Chemotherapy treatments to reduce it's size. By God's grace the tumor has reduced by about 35% but after major surgery a permanent defect in the leg cannot be ruled out as the tumor is adversely affecting even her sciatic nerve.

Chemotherapy treatment costs between Rs.20,000-Rs.30,000 per session. All the other tests and medicine expenses already exceed Rs.250,000. Surgery, scheduled for 11th November will cost Rs.300,000 plus other incidental expenses.

Her mediclaim is for a very small amount. Her father Rayomand Kerawala is a manager at the Ahmedabad Parsi Dharamshala and earns a monthly salary of only Rs.4,500. The family supplements it's income by serving meals to guests at the Dharamashala. They have received some help from the trustees of Ahmedabad Parsi Panchayat and are also applying to trusts in Mumbai.
